

Earth Day 2005 Campaign Aruba

This year on April 22, 2005 we commemorated the 35th anniversary of Earth Day, with the theme selected by Earth Day Network being "Protect Our Children and Our Future".

Rainbow Warriors International and Fundacion Accion Ambiental kicked off a joint campaign, called Earth Day 2005 Campaign, on April 18, 2005, focusing on this theme.

This campaign also addresses the issues of the Healthy Environments for Children Alliance, first promoted on World Health Day 2003, which had as its theme Shape the Future of Life: Healthy Environments for Children.

The key focus is on the clusters of issues of Air and Toxics, Healthy Schools and Healthy Home Environments.

Air and Toxics: Asthma, Air Pollution, Toxics and Mercury in Our Community

Many threats to children and youth are linked to chemicals found in food and the air we all breathe, and allergic reactions to these and diseases cause health problems, which can become chronic if untreated.

Healthy School Environments: Healthy Schools, Childhood Obesity

School children and students are often exposed to unhealthy situations due to poor indoor air quality, hazardous building materials and chemical contamination from e.g. exhaust gases in and around the school grounds.

Poor nutrition and bad dietary habits, and a lack of adequate physical exercise lead to additional health and learning problems.

Healthy Home Environments: Water

Quality, Protecting Children from Harmful Chemical Exposure, Healthy Homes, Urban Parks

Poor housing quality conditions can



lead to stress, health and learning problems and are often enhanced by existing social problems.

Bad plumbing leads to consumption of water with toxic metals that will seriously affect the physical and mental development of children.

Chemicals used in and around the house and building materials used for construction lead to exposure to harmful agents.

A lack of urban parks further reduces the possibilities of play and physical exercise, both essential to the healthy development of children and youth.

Campaign Objectives

This campaign, which runs until Earth Day 2006, has a threefold perspective on the threats to children in our community, by looking at the three aspects of sustainable development, being the economic, social and environmental components.

It is the intention to engage many stakeholders in this process, such as public health bodies, groups and organizations dedicated to working with youth and children, health care profession
