

What are children's environmental health indicators?

An expression of the link between the environment and children's health, targetted at an issue of specific policy or management concern, and represented in a form that facilitates interpretation for effective decision-making.





Why do we need children's environmental health indicators?

- To show time trends
 - to provide early warning of problems
 - to monitor effects of intervention
- To show spatial patterns
 - > to highlight hotspots
 - > to identify who is at risk
 - > to compare between countries

To define and motivate action

- > to specify causes
- > to attribute source
- to prioritise issues
- to identify and assess choices
- to inform those who need to know
