

Attending the conference from Venezuela were delegates from Fundacion Agua Clara, Fundacion Rio Manzanares and Fundacion Caribe Sur, from the island of Bonaire the Department of Physical Planning/Section Environment and Natural Resources and the park management authority STINAPA, from Colombia La Corporacion para el Desarrollo Sostenible del Archipielago de San Andres, Providencia y Santa Catalina (CORALINA), from Aruba Stichting Rainbow Warriors CORE (Rainbow Warriors International), and from Curacao delegates from the Meteorological Service Netherlands Antilles and Aruba, the Ministry of Health and the Environment (Section VOMIL-MINA), the Carmabi Institute (Curacao), the Department of Public Works of Curacao and a delegate from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Research Institute/Gulf and Caribbean Fisheries Institute.

International observers from the Coast Guard for the Netherlands Antilles and Aruba, the IMO-RAC-REMPEITC-Carib (Regional Marine Pollution Emergency, Information, and training Center Wider Caribbean), and Friends of the Earth International, represented by Amigu di Tera from Curacao, also attended.

Local observers from Aruba came from the Department of Agriculture, Husbandry and Fisheries, the Public Works Department, the National UNESCO Commission, the Department of Foreign Affairs, the Directorate of Shipping, the Aruba Tourism Authority, section Eco-tourism and WEB Aruba N.V.

The final outcome of the conference was a Resolution and a firm commitment to move forward.

The resolution calls for:

- The creation of a Steering Committee and Working Groups;
- Organization of a Coastal Zone Management Workshop and Training to be held in 2005;
- Establishment of a program with projects.

During the conference a SWOT (Strength and Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats) Analysis was compiled in Spanish ("Matriz de Información").
